## COACHES, PLAYERS ETC **VISITING THE UK FROM OVERSEAS**

1. Any overseas person or persons wishing to participate in polocrosse in the United Kingdom, eg, play, coach or umpire, must seek approval from their Home Association and the UKPA [United Kingdom Polocrosse Association] prior to their participation in the UK.
2. Any visiting Coach/Player/Umpire shall complete the attached form and forward through their Home National/State Association to the UKPA Chairman [see UKPA website for current contact details].

### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. **Insurance:** Whilst participating in UKPA approved polocrosse activities, Public liability insurance is provided through membership of the UKPA. It is strongly recommended that any person visiting the UK to participate in polocrosse activities secures appropriate personal insurance cover.
2. **To qualify to play at UKPA National Championships:** overseas players must be fully paid-up members of the UKPA, and also resident in the UK, by 1<sup>st</sup> June of the current year, and also have played at 2 or more UKPA tournaments in the current season.
